17. All ponies entered in Mountain & Moorland classes (43-55) must state the registration number on entry form.

18. Any competitor may enter classes 43-55, but your attention is drawn to conditions 19 -22.

19. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placed ponies / horses in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer National Championships. Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of P(UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 1st July and 31st July their membership must be submitted within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

20. Stallions/Colts may not be LED by any Juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to Ponies Association (UK). Any Stallion not exceeding 138cms or Welsh A & B stallions may NOT be ridden by any juniors who have not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to Ponies (UK). Stallions exceeding 138cms or Welsh C & D Stallions may not be ridden by Juniors who have NOT attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year at any show affiliated to Ponies (UK). In NPS affiliated classes riders of Stallions must have attained their 11th Birthday by the 1st January of the current year when riding Small Breeds. For Large Breeds riders of Stallions must have attained their 14th Birthday by the 1st January of the current year.

21. All Stallions and Colts must be adequately bitted.

22. NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Books. Part breders are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4-6th August 2010.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check memberships cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the final.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF THE SHOW GROUND

1. The Organisers and landowners will not hold themselves responsible for any accident or injury to spectators, owners, horse, pony, rider/handler or any other person, property or vehicle whatsoever however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action that may arise from any such incidents. The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. Everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials or Stewards.

2. The decision of the judge/judges shall be final.

3. **No horse/pony under 4 years of age may be ridden on the showground.** Foals must be at least three weeks old and shown in a halter or foal slip, and accompany the dam into the ring.

4. Horses and ponies must be kept at a walk on the show ground, except in the designated warming up areas, any rider who fails to observe this rule or is seen to ride dangerously, misuse the practise jump, or employ excessive use of whips or spurs, will be asked to leave the show ground. Lunging is allowable only with side reins to a snaffle bridle or cavesson. **No entry fees shall be refunded.**

5. The Organisers reserve the right to alter, sub-divide or amalgamate classes should the numbers so justify. Classes may be limited.

6. It is the Owner's due diligence to ensure that Horses and Ponies are not left unattended whilst tied to the side of Trailors or Lorries.

7. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, not be a nuisance or danger to other animals and people on the showground.

8. Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any JUDGE and/or OFFICIALS on the part of the exhibitor, groom, rider, handler will at the OFFICIALS discretion disqualify the animal, rider or handler from being judged. No entry fees shall be refunded.

9. A £2.00 surcharge will be added for First Aid cover and Administration.

10. Entries **will only be refunded** on production of a valid **Veterinary or Doctor's Certificate.** All claims must be made 10 days prior to or following the show date.

11. Entry fees will not be refunded if your classes clash, so **CHOOSE CAREFULLY.**

12. Listen to announcements made, get to the ring on time for your class/ classes **refunds will not** be given if you miss your class.

13. Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/ riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. **All children under the age of 14yrs must wear a British Standard riding hat when showing In-hand,** all competitors must be dressed appropriately when showing. It is recommended that riders do not wear earrings or body studs. No spurs may be worn in any Novice or M&M class or when warming up for NPS Affiliation classes. Whips not to exceed 30". In all classes except where stated any suitable bridle is acceptable.

14. Fall of horse / rider in the ring means elimination from that class. The rider **MUST NOT REMOUNT** in the ring.

15. Please use litterbins provided or take your litter home. This showground is grazed by livestock. No mucking out of Horseboxes or Trailers on the showground.

16. VET ON CALL. Should an injury occur during the show the duty veterinary surgeon will attend as soon as possible in exactly the same way he would for a private client. Being on call does not mean he is dedicated **SOLELY** to this show.

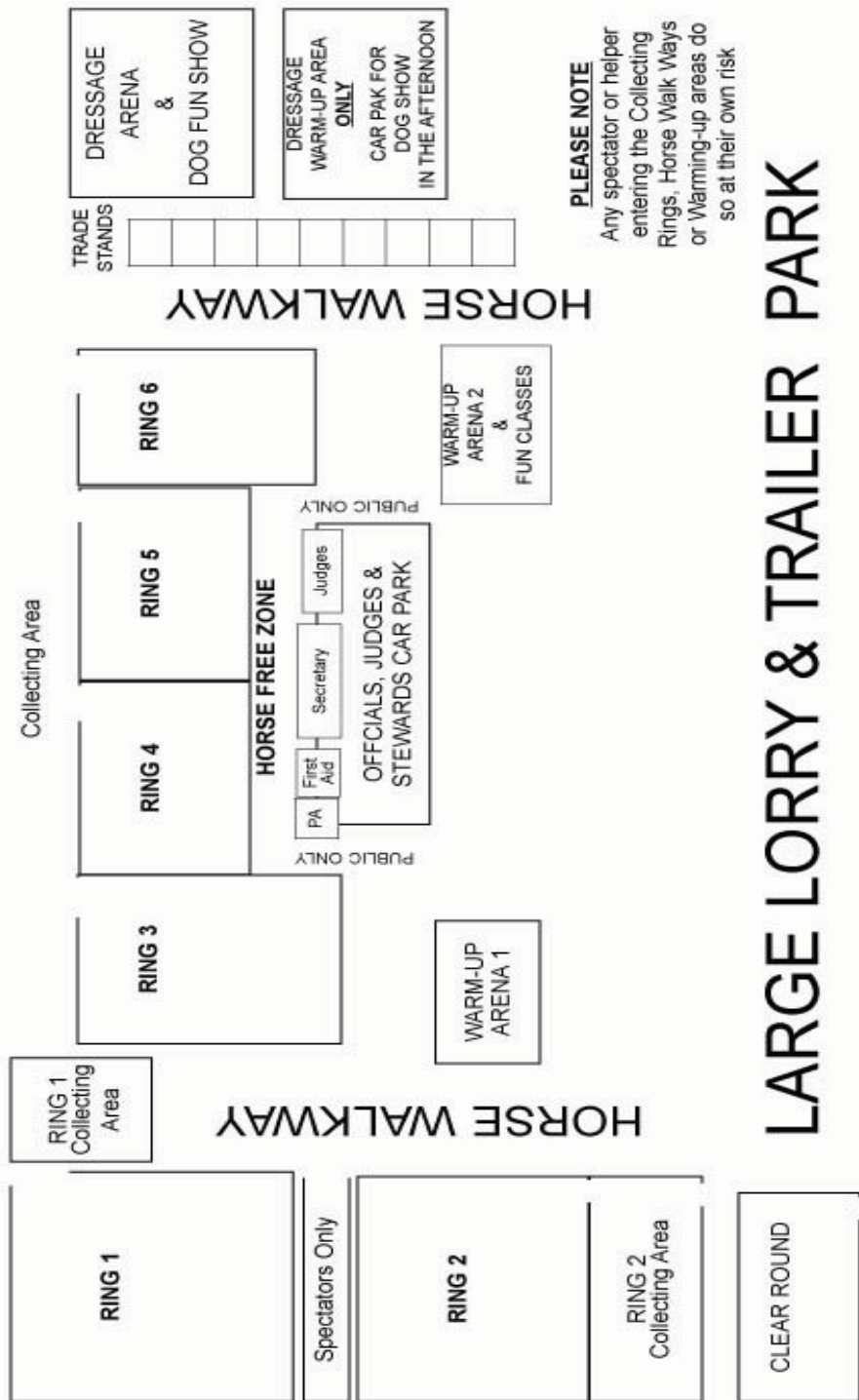
