Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Judges may use a mark sheet as a guide, but it is not obligatory. A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Member of the S.S.A., carrying their current Championship Points Card. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place.
