RULES

1. The organisers & the land owner accept no liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. No unauthorised persons to enter rings.
3. Riding hats, boots, **gloves, jackets** to be worn.
4. No horse or pony under 4 years may enter any of the ridden classes.
5. The judges decision is final.
6. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence & must be accompanied by £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
7. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to **cancellation** or **transferred** to another show if after close of entries.
8. Age (where applicable) as on the day of the show.
9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes & hold prize money if insufficient entries. min of 6 per class
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel any entry of any person if they deem fit to do so, without reason for doing so.
11. Anyone found galloping on the fields will be asked to leave.
12. The judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs.
13. **All horse droppings to be removed from the show ground or placed in bins provided**
14. It will be the responsibility of the rider if classes clash.
15. Competitors who disobey any judge or official's decision could be refused entry in future competitions.
16. Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times.
17. Riders arriving late may be allowed to take part at the judges discretion.
18. In the event of adverse weather, it is the competitor's responsibility to telephone the show secretary.
19. All dogs must be kept on a lead.
