

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All riders participate at their own risk and the Organiser and Landowner cannot accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or loss to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. The competition will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations as laid down by British Dressage. A copy of these Rules can be obtained from British Dressage on 02476 698 830.
3. Hard hats to PAS015 standard or similar must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are compulsory for all riding school pupils under 16 years old and recommended for all other riders.
4. The judge and ring steward's decisions are final. Riders who ignore any judge or official's instruction could be asked to leave the show ground and could be refused entry to any or all future events at Stocks Farm Equestrian Centre.
5. Any objections should be raised within 20 minutes of the alleged event and should be accompanied by a deposit of £15, which is refundable if the objection is upheld.
6. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry.
7. **All** dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
8. Young children must be supervised at all times.
9. Riders are requested to walk only in the lorry area and on the tracks. Trotting and cantering is permitted only in the warm up areas, and the show rings. Anyone found trotting or cantering in any other areas will be asked to leave the show ground.
10. No mucking out of trailers/lorries onto the show ground.
11. Entry fees will be refunded only on the production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.
12. In the event of extreme bad weather, please contact 01202 570 288 on the morning of the event.
13. No horse or pony under the age of 4 to be ridden on the show ground.
14. Spectators must not distract or attempt to distract the judge, please direct any queries to the stewards.
15. It is the competitor's responsibility to ring for their dressage times. Failure to do so may result in their place being given to another competitor.
16. In the instance of excess entries, a waiting list will be operated.

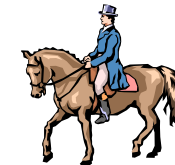


FUN DRESSAGE SHOW

FUN DRESSAGE CLASSES

Class 1 – Beginners Test

Test written by Stocks Farm Equestrian Centre and will require basic movements at walk and trot only. Please note no riders will be permitted to wear spurs in this class. Entries restricted to rider and horse combinations that have not previously been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a dressage competition

Class 2 – Intermediate Test

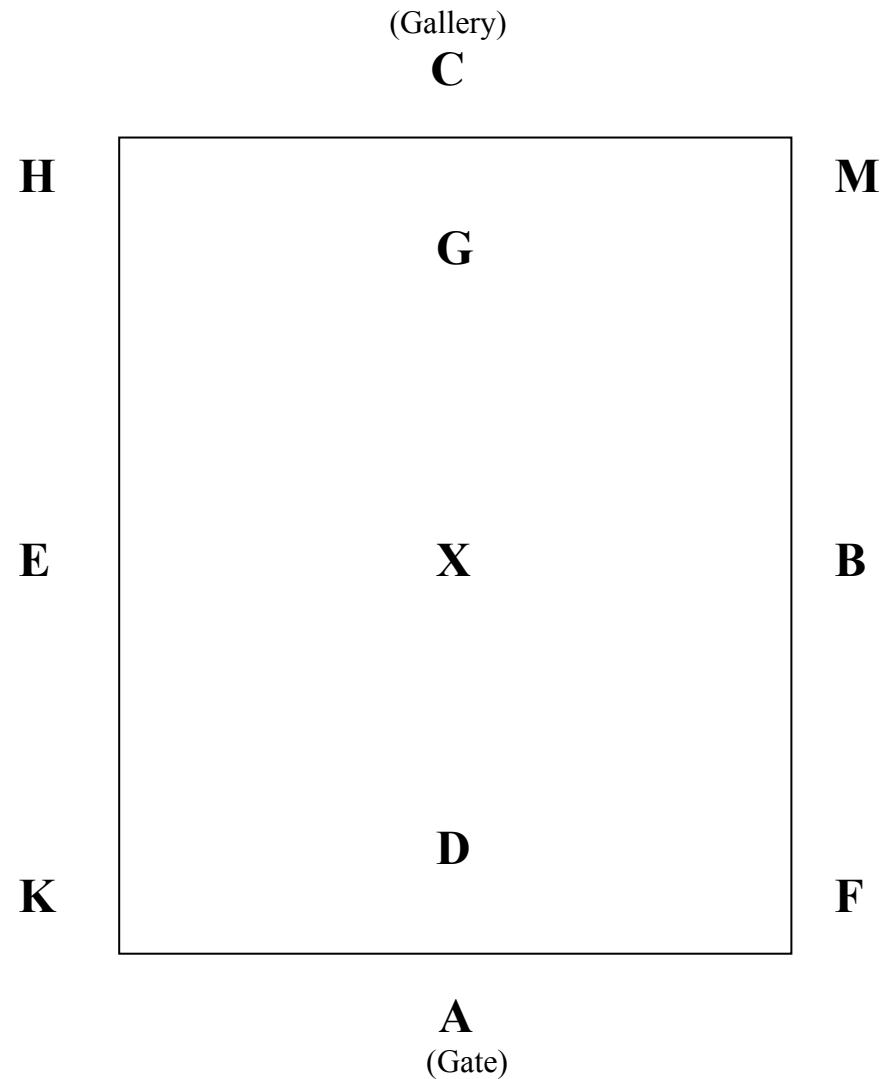
Test written by Stocks Farm Equestrian Centre and will require basic movements at walk, trot and canter. Entries restricted to rider and horse combinations that have not previously been placed 1st in a dressage competition

Class 3 – Prelim Test 13 (2006)/Novice Test 30 (2006)

British Dressage test. Open to all unaffiliated competitors. Class will be judged on the percentage scores. Competitors may ride both tests in this class, but must pay the entry fee for each test ridden

Please note that the tests will be held in the indoor arena and the warm up will be held in the outdoor arena.
