- 1) Won an open NPS affiliated M&M WHP class
- 2) Won a class at an M&M WHP (HOYS/RIHS) qualifying round
- 3) Qualified for the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship Show
- 4) Qualified for an M&M WHP final at HOYS/RIHS in previous years or in the current year

Class 33: Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section C mares and geldings four years old and over not exceeding 138cm (13.2hh), Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 34: Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara and Welsh Section D mares and geldings four years old and over exceeding 138cm but not exceeding 148cm (except for Welsh Section d and dales), Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A&B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128cm, Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year

CHAMPIONSHIP 1st and 2nd from classes 53 - 60

General Conditions

1. Any stallions not exceeding 138cms or small breed M&M stallions may not be ridden by juniors who have not attained their 11th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Stallions exceeding 138 cms or large breed M&M stallions may not be ridden by any junior who have not attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.
2. All stallions and colts 2 years old and over must hold a current stallions licence unless otherwise governed by their individual breed society.
3. The Tambrook show is run under NPS rules.
4. The decision of the judges and stewards is final.
5. All ridden horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.
6. No claim can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, their property, servants or horses in connection with or arising out of this event. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such an event.
7. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied with the correct fee and a signed entry form.
8. The promoters reserve the right to refuse an entry without giving any reason what so ever.
9. Any objection must be made within 30 minutes of the incident with a £20 deposit.
10. Correct riding attire must be worn by all competitors In line with NPS rules, in particular everyone mounted weather a competitor or not must wear a hat complying to BSEN1384 or PASO15 with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
11. No entry will be refunded unless a veterinary or medial certificate is produced no later that 4 days after the event.
12. The promoters reserve the right to cancel any class or the event at their discretion. Entry fees will be refunded less a small administration charge.
13. No spurs in any of the affiliated NPS classes.
14. No lunging in warm-up areas.
15. No mucking out in car park/show ground.
16. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times/ please use litter bins provided.
17. All foals must be at least 3 weeks old or over and accompany the dam in the ring.
18. **NPS Silver Medal Championship Conditions.** These Championships are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded where the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced in the ring. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card cannot be produced in the ring, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided the Owner is a Member of the NPS and the membership card is produced in the ring. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can only be awarded to the Champion or Reserve Champion
19. Any discourteous behaviour to any official will result in dismissal from the showground and no refund of entry fees.
20. Handlers of ponies in any inhand class aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current standard skull caps/riding hats.
21. No galloping/cantering on the showground except in the designated area.

22. The organisers reserve the right to substitute judges and if necessary move classes to another ring.
23. Where required all entries must be registered with their appropriate society, no entry will be accepted for these classes without a registration number.
24. A fall of pony or rider in any class will result in disqualification and the rider must not remount in the ring
25. .National pony society summer championships are 5th-7th August 2009.
26. Competitors entering classes which may clash do so entirely at their own risk.
27. No classes will be held up under any circumstances except as authorised by the show director or other officials of the show.
28. **NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds**: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Ponies to be trimmed only within their Breed Society specification. Manes must not be plaited and tails must not be braided. All ponies in Novice Classes must be shown in one of the snaffle bits illustrated in the NPS Official List of Judges and Rules.
29. Qualifying rounds are open to both NPS Members and Non Members but only the highest placed NPS Adult member, on production of their membership card in the ring, will be eligible to qualify for the Final. A valid Membership Card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring.
30. The first prize winners from each class will go forward to the Final to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show, Malvern, in August 2010. A pony may only qualify once. Where the first pony in the class has already qualified, the pony standing next in line which has not qualified will be deemed the qualifier. Qualification may go no lower than third place.
31. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final. Qualified Ponies must be entered into the NPS Competition Final within 14 days for the pony to be eligible to appear in the Final.
