THREE EVENT COMPETITION

Class A; Open

Dressage Intro B (walk/trot) held on Saturday 15th May

Showjumping – jumps not exceeding 1ft 9in – held on Sunday 16th May

Handy Pony held on Sunday 16th May

Class B; Open

Dressage Prelim 19 held on Saturday 15th May

Showjumping – jumps not exceeding 2ft – held on Sunday 16th May

Handy Pony held on Sunday 16th May

Class C; Open

Dressage Novice 37 held on Saturday 15th May

Showjumping – jumps not exceeding 2ft 6in – held on Sunday 16th May

Handy Pony held on Sunday 16th May

ROSETTES: 1ST – 6TH place in each class. Trophy to each class winner.

Special Rosette to highest placed WDRC member in each class (WDRC Club badge must be worn to qualify)

For your score to be included in the Open Dressage and/or Handy Pony competition an additional entry fee(s) for the Open Dressage and/or Handy Pony must be received. You will only ride one dressage test or complete one Handy Pony course

The same horse/rider combination must complete all three phases.

DRESSAGE CLASSES

Class 1

Introductory B (2009) Walk/Trot test

Test to be ridden on 20m x 40m grass arena

Class 2

PRELIM 19 (2008) Open

Test to be ridden on 20m x 60m all-weather surface

Class 3

PRELIM 13 (2006) Open

Test to be ridden on 20m x 40m grass arena

Class 4

PRELIM 10 (2002) / NOVICE20 (2007) Open; placings to be awarded on % basis. Please state on entry form which test you wish to ride

Test to be ridden on 20m x 40m grass arena

Class 5

NOVICE 37 (2007) Open

Test to be ridden on 20m x 60m all-weather surface

This competition will be run under British Dressage rules APART from the fact that hats to PAS015 or EN1384 must be worn

ROSETTES: 1ST – 6TH place in each class.

Special Rosette to highest placed WDRC member in each class (WDRC Club badge must be worn to qualify)

DIRECTIONS Please look at our website for a map!

Coming from Wimborne By-Pass; take A349 towards Poole. Just past pedestrian crossing, turn right into Merley Park Road (postbox on corner), signposted towards Ashington & Corfe Mullen

Coming from Poole/Bournemouth; at traffic lights at junction of Queen Anne Drive & Gravel Hill, take A349 towards Wimborne. Merley Park Road is the third road on left hand side, signposted towards Ashington & Corfe Mullen

Continue along Merley Park Road – DO NOT TURN INTO GRAVEL TRACK TO HIGHER MERLEY FARM!

The WDRC Field is approx. ¼ mile past the last house, on the left hand side, through a large double gateway

SUNDAY 16TH MAY 2010

HANDY PONY

To start at 10am. Priority to be given to three-event competition riders. The course will comprise 10 obstacles to be negotiated and marked out of 10 by a judge. In the event of a tie in the marks, the time taken to complete the course will be taken into consideration.

No whips/spurs allowed.

CLEAR ROUND

To be held from 10am to 12 noon. Jumps to start at 1ft 9 in. Height of jumps to be raised at ½ hourly intervals

SHOW JUMPING PHASE OF THREE EVENT COMPETITION

To start at 12 noon

Class 1A; THREE EVENT COMPETITION

Jumps not to exceed 1ft 9in

Class 2A; THREE EVENT COMPETITION

Jumps not to exceed 2ft

Class 3A; THREE EVENT COMPETITION

Jumps not to exceed 2ft 6in

Maximum length of whip 75cms/30inches

1. Neither the organisers, landowner, nor any person acting on their behalf, shall be responsible for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, owners or personal property. Admission is granted & entry accepted on these conditions
2. Hard hats to standard EN1384, PAS015 or ASTM SE1-F1163, with chin straps correctly fastened, and appropriate riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted
3. The Judge's decision is final AT ALL TIMES
4. Any complaints must be made in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the alleged incident and accompanied by a £10 deposit, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
5. All horses/ponies ridden at the Show must be aged 4 years & over on the day of the Show
6. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES. OWNERS MUST PROVIDE BAGS AND CLEAR UP ANY MESS LEFT BY THEIR DOG!
7. No horse/pony to be ridden by more than one rider in each class
8. Excessive use of the practice jump is forbidden. Anyone found abusing or galloping their horse/pony will be asked to leave the showground and will be refused entry to any or all future WDRC events
9. It is recommended that all competitors wear approved, correctly fitted body protectors. Protectors may be worn over jackets if required
10. Entry fees are non-refundable under any circumstances
11. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry
