

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Classes will be run in accordance with the current British Riding Clubs Rule Book.
2. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the Organisers, Landowners and his Agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants, caused on the showground.
3. In all cases the judges decision is final. Any objection must be accompanied by a deposit of £20 and made within half an hour of the said offence. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
4. Correct dress shall be worn. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015 or prefixed ASTM OR SEI are the minimum standard allowed. Recommended hats should carry the quality assurance stamp of Kitemark or SEI. American standard SNELL E2001 and Australian/New Zealand standard SNZ 3838 1998 are also acceptable. Where a hat is of skullcap style, this must be worn with a coloured silk. No fixed peaks.
5. A Body Protector to BETA standard Class 3 (purple label) is compulsory. It is recommended that body protectors are worn in accordance with the manufacturers' instructions.
6. Medical Armbands are compulsory. (Obtainable from the BHS Bookshop Tel: 01926 707700.)
7. Competitors are forbidden to carry mobile telephones whilst competing.
8. Watches capable of being started, stopped and capable of recording time elapsed are forbidden.
9. Horses must be 4 years of age or older. Horses may only be ridden once in each class.
10. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times in the car parking area and are not allowed on the cross country course.
11. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the show, alter classes, judges, times or any other published information.
12. Refund of entry fees less £2 will be made only on production of a vet's or doctor's certificate, except in the event of cancellation where all fees will be refunded less 15%.
13. It is strongly recommended that all horses and ponies are inoculated against equine influenza.
If the horse is deemed unfit or unwell the organisers have the right to have the animal removed from the showground.
14. Competitors having difficulty with an obstacle must clear the area if a following competitor is approaching the obstacle. Competitors will be sent off the course if they do not move on after 3 refusals.
15. It is a condition of entry that competitors keep to the flagged route to minimise damage to crops. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

DIRECTIONS:

Nether Wallop can be approached either from:

- (i) A343 Salisbury to Andover road; or
- (ii) A30 Stockbridge to Salisbury road.
- (iii) B3084 Romsey to Grateley/Tidworth road.

At Nether Wallop follow the CRC signs to Dene Farm.

Fence height 2'9" Maximum. Bogey Time: 450metres/minute.
Horses over 14.2 hh. Horse/rider combination not to have won £50
or more in any hunter trial.

CLASS 2 Horses over 14.2hh.

CLASS 3 Ponies 14.2 hh and under.

2'6" NOVICE

Fence height: 2'6" Maximum. Bogey Time: 435metres/minute.
Horse/rider combination not to have been
placed 1st or 2nd in any hunter trial at this height

CLASS 4 Horses over 14.2 hh.

CLASS 5 Ponies 14.2 hh and under.

2'3" NOVICE

Fence height: 2' - 2'3" Maximum. Bogey Time: 400metres/minute.
This course is designed to encourage inexperienced ponies or riders.
Horse/rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any hunter
trial at this height.

CLASS 6 Horses over 14.2 hh.

CLASS 7 Ponies 14.2 hh and under.

CLASS 8 2'3" NOVICE PAIRS HUNTER TRIAL

Horses and ponies any height. Horses jump singly, apart from three
fences, which are to be jumped side by side (judged on dressing).
These fences to be shown on the course plan.
Bogey Time: 435metres/minute.
