

Rules

1. The organisers & landowners do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. No unauthorized persons to enter arenas.
3. Hard hats and appropriate riding clothes must be worn.
4. No horse or pony under 4 years may enter any of the ridden classes.
5. The Judge's decision is final.
6. No illegal assistance by spectators.
7. No horse or pony to be ridden by more than one rider in any one event except clear round jumping.
8. Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £10 which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
9. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors (unless accompanied by a veterinary certificate).
10. Competitors who enter more than one class which may clash do so at their own risk. Classes will not be held up and no entries will be refunded.
11. Age (where applicable) as on the day of the 1st show of the series.
12. Crofton Manor EC reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and withhold prize money if insufficient entries.
13. The centre reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry or entries of any Person if they shall deem it fit to do so without reason for doing so.
14. Anyone found galloping around the arenas will be asked to leave.
15. The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs. Whips over 30" in length are not allowed.
16. No lungeing.
17. Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times.
18. Please remove all droppings/hay from the showground
19. All dogs to kept on the lead
20. In the event of adverse weather conditions, please call the secretary on 01329 667323.
21. The competition will run under BSJA Rules & Regulations.

RIDDEN SHOWING CLASSES

Indoor Arena - Ring 1

Not to start before 12pm

Class 11 - Best Conditioned and Turned Out Horse and Rider

Special rosette for best plaited mane and tail.

Class 12 – Lead Rein – Non Show Type

Riders 13yrs & under. Judged purely on suitability as a lead rein pony, not on confirmation. Rosettes to all.

Class 13 – Novice Rider

This class is for genuine novice horse/ponies and riders. Optional Canter in individual show. Special to highest placed rider 13yrs & under.

Class 14 – First Ridden

Riders 14 yrs & under, ponies 14.2hh & under. Cantering only allowed in individual show.

Class 15 – Best Rider

Special rosette to oldest rider

Class 16 - Mountain & Moorland

Any height

Class 17 – Ridden Veterans

15 years and over – special rosette for oldest horse/pony. Age to be displayed.

Class 18 – Ridden Coloureds, Spots, Palominos, Duns and Roans

Any height

Class 19 – Ridden Heavies & Hairies

Any height

SHOW JUMPING

Outdoor Arena – Ring 3

Start 9.00am

Class 20 - 1'6 Minimus jumping

1 round against the clock.

(Led and Unled sections – Please specify on entry form)

Horse/rider combinations never to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a jumping competition.

Class 21 – 2'0 Pairs Relay

1 round each against the clock passing a whip between rounds

Class 22 - 2'3 – 2 Phase

1st phase 7 fences if you jump clear then 2nd phase 5 fences against the clock.

Class 23 – Little and Large

1st rider jumps 6 fences 1'6-1'9. 2nd rider jumps 6 fences 2'6-2'9.

Both rounds against the clock.

Class 24 - 2'6 – 2 Phase

1st phase 7 fences if you jump clear then 2nd phase 5 fences against the clock.

Class 25 – Top Score

2'3" – 2'6" Joker 2'9" Each competitor has 60 seconds to clock up as many points as possible.

Class 26 – 2'9 – 2 Phase

1st phase 7 fences if you jump clear then 2nd phase 5 fences against the clock.

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

Outdoor Arena - Ring 4

Start 9.00am

To run all day – Height to run concurrently with classes.

£4 per round with rosette, £3 per round without. Payable on the day.

Rosettes to 6th place in all classes unless otherwise specified
