

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Rosettes will be the only prizes awarded to the first six places unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

2. The judge's decision is final.

Any objection must be handed to the Secretary in writing with ten pounds deposit, no later than 15 minutes after the incident. If the objection is sustained the deposit will be returned.

3. The promoters, Organizers and Landowners ('The Committee') shall not be libel for any claim in respect of damage to any person, horse/pony or other property of any kind howsoever it may have been caused. It is the express condition of entry that each competitor shall hold the Committee harmless and that he or she shall indemnify the Committee against any legal proceedings, action, expenses, costs, claims, demands or damage whatsoever arising from any accident or other incident which may occur.

5. The Committee implements their own risk assessment but still expects everyone at the show to take reasonable responsibility for their own Health and Safety whilst on the show site.

4. All vehicles attend the show at the owner's risk.

5. Any persons riding animals on the show site must wear hard hats to the current standards.

6. The Show Committee reserves the right to change Judges without prior warning.

7. All competitors **must** sign the section on the entry form stating that they have third party insurance cover or will accept responsibility for any damage they or their animals or associates may do.

8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry without giving a reason.

9. The Committee reserves the right to bar entry or ask any person to leave the show ground without giving a reason.

10. All ponies and horses to be ridden in snaffle bits please. When performing tests no martingales, boots or bandages to be worn

11. Dressage tests will be ridden on grass.
