6. Non Traditional Vehicle For Forest Drive Best Photo Marmalvan Champion sash to winner Judge Mrs. E. Sutherland
Judged from a distance without close inspection. This will include the vehicle, animal, driver and passengers. Turned out to create a safe whilst smart / casual general impression suitable to enjoy a drive in the country.

7. In Hand Best Driving Type (Any age and any height) Jo Halnan-Blackwell Champion sash to winner Judge Mrs. E. Sutherland

8A. Ride & Drive (Ridden Section) Mrs. A. S. Sinclair class winner rosette Judge Mrs. E. Sutherland
Competitor will be asked to exhibit all paces as a group & perform an individual show. Competitors will be placed in order. Marks corresponding to numbers in class will be awarded. (Highest marks to the winner, then in descending order.)

9. Light Trade & Commercial Marmalvan class winner rosette Judge Mr. M.J. Kesans
Open to 2 and 4 wheeled vehicles

13. Veteran Horse Or Pony (15years and over) Jo Halnan-Blackwell class winner rosette Judge Mr. M.J. Kesans
This class will take into account the turnout, general condition and movement of the animal.

14. Novice Horse Or Pony Jo Halnan-Blackwell class winner rosette Judge Mr. M.J. Kesans
Horse or pony not to have won a first or second place in any driven showing classes. A groom must accompany every whip. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and suitability of horse or pony and harness for a novice.

15. Best Novice Whip Jo Halnan-Blackwell class winner rosette Judge Mr. M.J. Kesans
Open to a whip (including Junior whips) that have never won a first prize in any show driving competition. Any vehicle may be used. A groom must accompany every whip. The competition is judged to determine the capabilities of the driver, particular attention will be paid to correct dress, turnout and driving procedures

16. Driven Coloured Horse / Pony Single Or Multiple Jo Halnan-Blackwell class winner rosette Judge Mr. M.J. Kesans
Open to horses or ponies of any height, 4 years old and over, piebald, skewbald or spotted animal driven to any vehicle. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and suitability and way of going of the horse or pony.

17. Exercise Vehicle Mrs. A. S. Sinclair class winner rosette Judge Mrs. A. Lewis
Horse or pony driven to an exercise vehicle. To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and suitability and way of going of the horse or pony
(m) Osborne Refrigeration Championship Qualifier Single Turnout driven to a four-wheel exercise vehicle
(n) Osborne Refrigeration Championship Qualifier Pair or tandem put to an exercise vehicle

18. Pleasure Driving Class Mrs. A. S. Sinclair class winner rosette Judge Mrs. A. Lewis
For newcomers to showing and not intended for those who show in private driving classes. Regular showing competitors are asked to respect this and entries will not be accepted for the Pleasure Driving class from competitors who enter the Private Driving class at this show. Open to any type of vehicle. To be judged, 15% vehicle suitability, fit and cleanliness. 15% harness suitability, fit & cleanliness. 70% driver & groom, horse / pony, way of going and suitability as a family pleasure animal. Competitors may be asked to drive and halt between two pairs of cones and execute a U-turn in their individual show.

19. Turnout Best Suited To Forest Driving Mrs. A. S. Sinclair class winner rosette Judge Mrs. A. Lewis
To be judged on general cleanliness, safety of turnout, correct fitting of harness and suitability of horse or pony
NFPPG rosette to highest placed 'Forest Bred' with a white armband. NFPERC rosette to highest placed member with a green armband.

8B. Ride & Drive (Driven Section) Mrs. A. S. Sinclair Champion sash to the class winner Judge Mrs. A. Lewis
To be judged as a Private Driving class. Competitors will be placed in order. Marks corresponding to numbers in class will be awarded. (Highest marks to the winner, then in descending order.) Ridden and driven marks will be totalled. Finally competitors will be drawn out in order. Highest award going to the highest marks. Tied placing awarded to the highest placed competitor of the two in the driven section.
