

Rules and Conditions of Entry

It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, landowners and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors or spectators or their property whilst on the showground

New Forest Pony Breed Society Showing Rules

1. Ponies are shown unplaited, but may have lightly pulled manes and tails. The jaw line and heels may be trimmed, but the whiskers should be left untrimmed.
2. Clipping, *except* for the legs, is allowed for ponies 4 years and over, in in-hand, ridden and working pony classes.
3. No make up is allowed or any other falsification of markings
4. Yearlings should not be shown in bits. Stud Stallions 2 years and over may be shown in bridles with bits. Chifney bits are not allowed in any circumstances. No ponies under 4 in ridden classes.
5. Judges have been asked to take behaviour and temperament into account and not to judge ponies whose behaviour they consider to be a danger to either its handler/rider or other competitors. Such a pony will be asked to leave the ring.
6. No commercial, stud, or pony names to be displayed in the ring.
7. A consensus was agreed in Council, June 2000, that 2 year old colts are permitted to be shown without a licence

Health and Safety

Class One

Yearlings

(May be divided if sufficient entries)

Class Two

Two and three year old colts.

(May be split by age if numbers suffice)

Class Three

(a) Two year old filly

(b) Two year old gelding

(May be combined if insufficient entries)

Class Four

(a) Three year old filly

(b) Three year old gelding

(May be combined if insufficient entries)

Class Five

a) Four years old and over mare or gelding

b) Four years old and over stallion

Ridden Classes

All classes open to Registered New Forest Ponies only

Ponies not to have been placed 1st to 3rd in M & M or NF ridden classes. Snaffle bridles only, no spurs allowed. **Ponies 4 years old and over**

Not before 12.30 pm

Class Six

Nursery ridden class for mares & geldings that have **never been ridden in the ring before**. All heights and all ages. No stallions allowed in this class.

Section a)i) Without cantering not exceeding 138cms

Section a ii) Without cantering exceeding 138 cms

Section bi) With cantering not exceeding 138 cms

Section bii) With cantering exceeding 138 cms

Class Seven

Ridden New Forest ponies not exceeding 138cms

Class Eight

Ridden New Forest ponies exceeding 138cms

Class Nine Novice Junior Practice Ridden

New Forest pony not exceeding 148cms ridden by a junior 16 yrs and under on the 1st January 2010. May be divided by height

Class Ten

Ridden Stallion
