

Rules & Regulations

1. In the event of the Show being cancelled, no refunds given, as the event will be rescheduled for another date.
2. The judge's decision is **final at all times**.
3. Riding Hats to the current standard and correct footwear must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
4. No unauthorised persons are allowed in the showing rings.
5. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
6. Competitors who enter classes that clash do so at their own risk and **no refund** will be given.
7. All horses/ponies must be ready to enter the ring when called.
8. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors, unless accompanied by a veterinary certificate.
9. The organisers & landowners do not accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, rider's spectators or personal property at any event.
10. All Cheques are to be made payable to 'New Forest Agricultural Show Society'.
11. In the event of large entries, classes may be divided & additional rosettes will be given.
12. No galloping or misuse of horses/ponies is allowed on the showground.
13. No Skipping out of lorries or trailers on the showground.
14. In adverse conditions, all vehicles would be parked on stone tracks.
15. In the event of adverse weather conditions, please call the secretary on 01590 622400.
16. No exhibitor can enter the ring once the first trot round has taken place.

Judge –

- 1 **BEST TURNED OUT** - Any height and age. Ridden or In Hand
- 2 **CHILD'S PONY** - On or off lead rein. Suitable for child rider, to be judged on temperament/suitability - not conformation
- 3 **FAMILY PONY** - Suitable for any member of the family to ride
- 4 **IN HAND VETERAN PONY/HORSE** - 18 years old and over. Exhibitors any age. (Please state the age of the animal on the entry form)
- 5 **YOUNG HANDLER** - Animals any height. Handler 9 years and under
- 6 **YOUNG HANDLER** - Animals any height. Handlers 10-14 years old

- 7 **LEADING REIN PONY** - Mare or gelding, four years old and over. Any height and age. Suitable for beginners
- 8 **FIRST RIDDEN** - Mare or gelding, four years old and over. Any height and age. Suitable for beginners, riders 12 years and under
- 9 **RIDDEN VETERAN PONY/HORSE** - 18 years old and over. Exhibitors any age. May be led. (Please state the age of the animal on the entry form)
- 10 **FANCY DRESS** - A voucher to winner
- 11 **BEST CONDITION - GRASS KEPT** - Any height and age
- 12 **BEST CONDITION - STABLED** - Any height and age

CLEAR ROUND JUMPING

Ring Commencing 10.00am

- 45 **2'0 NOVICE** - Combination not to have won 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any jumping competitions (two rounds, second against clock)
- 46 **2'3 OPEN JUMPING** - two phases if you jump the first part of the course clear you will be instructed to continue onto the second round that is against the clock
- 47 **2'6 OPEN JUMPING** - (two rounds, second against the clock)
- 48 **2'9 SPEED STAKES** - (one single round against the clock)
- 49 **3'0 OPEN JUMPING** - two phases if you jump the first part of the course clear you will be instructed to continue onto the second round that is against the clock

RING 2 – Commencing at 9.00am

Judge –

- 13 **IN HAND HEAVIES AND HAIRIES** - Any age and any height. Heavy horses and part breeds, special rosette for best natural mane and tail
- 14 **IN HAND APPALOOSA, PALOMINO, SPOTTED, MINIATURE** - Any age and height
- 15 **IN HAND BEST PROSPECTIVE DRIVING PONY/HORSE** - Any height and any age

Championship classes 13 - 15

- 16 **IN HAND HUNTER/SPORTS HORSE** - Any height and age
- 17 **IN HAND ARAB, ANGLO, PART BRED, EUROPEAN & WORLD BREEDS** - Any height and age

- 43 **OPEN WORKERS** - Four years old and over, under 148cms. To jump 2'9
- 44 **OPEN WORKERS** - Four years old and over, over 148cms. To jump 3'3
