- Class 1 Welsh Section A & B. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding
- Class 2 Welsh Section A & B. 4 years old or over. Stallion, mare or gelding
- Class 3 Welsh Section C & D. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding
- Class 4 Welsh Section C & D. 4 years old or over. Stallion, mare or gelding

- Class 5 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding

Class 12 Registered Part – Bred M & M. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding (Yearling Special)

Class 13 Registered Part – Bred M & M. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

- Class 16 Hunter Pony. 4 years old or over not exc 153cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

- Class 18 Riding Pony. 2 or 3 year old not to exc 148cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding.
- Class 19 Riding Pony. 4 years old or over not to exc 148cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 17 - 19 to come forward

NPS / The Boyles Family Show Pony In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony in the Show Pony In Hand section. (Please check information at the end of this schedule)

RING TWO - NOT BEFORE 11 AM -

Class 20 Registered Pure, Part or Anglo Arab. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding (Yearling Special)

Class 21 Registered Pure, Part or Anglo Arab. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 20 – 21 to come forward

Ridden – Judge – Mrs J Cuming

- Class 22 Part Bred Ridden. 4 years or over not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding. Rider any age
- Class 23 Ridden Registered Pure, Part or Anglo Arab. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding. Rider any age.
- Class 24 Novice Ridden Coloured pony not exceeding 153cm. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding. Rider any age. Not to have won a ridden coloured class before the day of the show.
- Class 25 Ridden Piebald/Skewbald Pony. 4 years old or over. Stallion, mare or gelding. not exceeding 153cm. Open to any type. Rider any age.

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 22 – 25 to come forward

RING THREE – 9 AM START

Class 26 Novice mare or gelding under 153cm never to have appeared in the ring under saddle before the day of the show.
Riders any age

Class 27 Novice stallion under 153cm not to have won a 1st prize under saddle at an affiliated show. Rider any age

Class 28 Novice mare or gelding under 153cm not to have won a 1st prize under saddle at an affiliated show. Rider any age

Class 29 Hunter Pony not exceeding 153cm, mare or gelding. Rider any age

Class 30 Riding Pony not exceeding 148cm mare or gelding. Rider any age

Class 31 Leading Rein not exceeding 122cm mare or gelding. Rider 10 years old or under on the day of the show. Please note rule 5.

Class 32 First Ridden not exceeding 128 mare or gelding. Rider 12 years old or under on the day of the show. Please note rule 5.

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 26 – 32 to come forward

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2010. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply. In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2009/2010 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2010 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

Class 33 NPS / T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

Class 34 NPS / KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

Class 35 NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Class 36 NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – small breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book
Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 37 NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules). Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 38 NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – large breeds

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 33 – 38 to come forward

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 4-6th August 2010.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. To be judged under NPS rules. These may be obtained from The National Pony Society Tel 01420 88333 or www.nationalponysociety.org.uk
2. All ponies in Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and conform to the height limits laid down by their Breed Societies. There is no height limit for Welsh Cobs, Section D.
3. All stallions and colts, 2 years old or over, must be in possession of a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. Stallions and colts, two years old or over must be adequately bitted.
5. All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before the 1st January in the current year
6. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years or under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
7. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 11 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
8. In Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony classes riders must be 11 years old or over when riding stallions not exceeding 128 cm and 14 years old or over when riding stallions exceeding 128 cms.
9. In all classes whips / canes must not exceed 75 cm. (30").
10. The decision of the Judge is final. Any objection must be handed in to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit.
11. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or sub-divide any class as may seem justified.
12. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without giving a reason.
13. Every effort has been made when drawing up the schedule of events to avoid classes coinciding, but in the event of having ponies entered in classes which do take place at the same time, the exhibitor must choose which class to enter and **NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE. No entry into the ring once the rope is across the entrance.**
14. All vehicles parked at owner's risk.
15. No entry fees will be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is presented.
16. Neither the Committee nor the Landowner will be held responsible for any accident or damage to persons, animals or property on the showground.
17. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
18. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog toilet picked up and removed.
19. We strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
20. In the event of cancellation a proportion of entry fees may be withheld.
