Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. All riders participate at their own risk and the Organiser and Landowner cannot accept any liability for damage, accident, injury or loss to horses, riders, spectators or personal property.
2. The Dressage competition will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations as laid down by British Dressage. A copy of these Rules can be obtained from British Dressage on 02476 698 830
3. Hard hats to PAS015 standard or similar must be worn at all times when mounted. Body protectors are compulsory for all riding school pupils under 16 years old and recommended for all other riders.
4. The judge and ring steward's decisions are final. Riders who ignore any judge or official's instruction could be asked to leave the show ground and could be refused entry to any or all future events at Stocks Farm Equestrian Centre.
5. Any objections should be raised within 20 minutes of the alleged event and should be accompanied by a deposit of £15, which is refundable if the objection is upheld.
6. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry.
7. **All** dogs must be kept on a lead at **all** times.
8. Young children must be supervised at all times.
9. Riders are requested to walk only in the lorry area and on the tracks. Trotting and cantering is permitted only in the warm up areas, and the show rings. Anyone found trotting or cantering in any other areas will be asked to leave the show ground.
10. No mucking out of trailers/lorries onto the show ground.
11. Entry fees will be refunded only on the production of a valid vet or doctor's certificate.
12. No horse or pony under the age of 4 to be ridden on the show ground.
13. Spectators must not distract or attempt to distract the judges, please direct any queries to the stewards
14. It is the competitor's responsibility to ring for their dressage times. Failure to do so may result in their place being given to another competitor.
15. In the instance of excess entries, a waiting list will be operated.
16. In the event of extreme bad weather, please contact 01202 570288 on the morning of the event. If the event is cancelled, all advance entries will be refunded, less an administration fee of £1.50 per competitor.
17. Stallions of 2 years or more must be licensed and must be handled by persons who have attained their 14th Birthday by or on the date of the show.

Skewbalds, piebalds, duns, roans, palaminos and appaloosas

Class 15 – Novice Working Hunter Horse or Pony

Will be required to jump a short course of fences up to 2' high. Riders may be led over the course. Only competitors jumping a clear round will be called back into the ring. Horse or pony not to have been placed previously in any working hunter class

Handlers to be 16 years old and under on the show day

Class 10 – Fancy Dress – lead rein and mounted entries

Class 16 – Best Black, Bay, Chestnut or Grey Horse or Pony

Class 17 – Novice Horse or Pony

Horse or pony not to have been placed 1st in any showing class. Class to be split if sufficient entries

Class 18 - Mountain and Moorland

Pure Breeds only – Large and small.

Class 19 - Family Horse or Pony

Horse or Pony suitable for any member of the family. May be required to jump a small fence.

Class 20 – Working Hunter Horse/Pony

Will be required to jump a short course of fences up to 2'6". Only competitors jumping a clear round will be called back into the Ring. No lead rein entries permitted in this class.
