Class 19 – Side Saddle Association EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN QUALIFYING CLASS

Judge; Miss J Strange

Run under SSA rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to SSA members and non-members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship points.

SIDE SADDLE INTERNATIONAL offer a rosette to the Adult Member and MANOR GRANGE STUD SHOW CENTRE to the Junior Member judged to be the Best Turned Out

Class 20 – FAMILY HORSE/PONY

Horse/Pony any height, to be suitable for several members of the family to ride. Snaffle bridle & cavesson noseband only.

Class 21 – SIDE SADDLE CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by the horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of the rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted.

Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required but the Judge may ask groups of three or four riders to give short displays.

Three Special rosettes will be awarded: to the highest placed Adult rider wearing a silk hat; to the highest placed Adult rider wearing a bowler hat and to the highest placed Junior, provided they are members of the SSA.

N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors must wear hats to the current British Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk

Class 22 – NON-SHOW TYPE

Horse/Pony 4 years and over, any height. Riders any age. Scars and blemishes will not be taken into consideration in the judging of this class but the horse/pony must be sound

Any age. Special rosette to best yearling

Coming from Wimborne By-Pass; take A349 towards Poole. Just past the pedestrian crossing, turn right into Merley Park Road (postbox on corner), signposted towards Ashington & Corfe Mullen

Coming from Poole/Bournemouth; at traffic lights at junction of Queen Anne Drive & Gravel Hill, take A349 towards Wimborne. Merley Park Road is the third road on left hand side, signposted towards Ashington & Corfe Mullen

Continue along Merley Park Road – PLEASE DO NOT TURN INTO HIGHER MERLEY FARM TRACK!
WDRC Field is approx. ¼ mile past the last house, on the left hand side, through a large double gateway

SHOW RULES

1. All persons riding on the showground must be wearing a hard hat. Failure to do so will result in £10 fine
2. Any complaints must be made in writing with £10 deposit, within 30 minutes of the alleged incident. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is upheld
3. The Judge's decision is final at all times
4. **ALL DOGS TO BE KEPT ON A LEAD. OWNERS MUST PROVIDE BAGS AND CLEAR UP ANY MESS LEFT BY THEIR DOG!**
5. In the event of low entries, the Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes and withhold prize monies and rosettes
6. In the event of large numbers of entries, classes may be divided and additional prizes and rosettes given
7. No unauthorised persons are allowed in the show ring
8. All horses/ponies must be ready to enter the ring when called. **COMPETITORS ENTERING CLASSES THAT MAY CLASH DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK.** No entry fees will be refunded
9. Collecting ring stewards in all classes can refuse late entries if judging has started
10. Any Entire horse/pony over 2 years old **MUST** have the appropriate licence available for inspection at the show
11. Brood mares must be shown with **OWN** foal at foot or have their Certificate of Service available for inspection at the show
12. All foals must be aged **FOUR WEEKS OR MORE** on the day of the show
13. Horses/ponies will be measured in the case of a dispute
14. All cups and trophies are to be signed for before leaving the showground and must be returned by 15th June 2011
15. All Mountain & Moorland ponies must be registered in the NPS Stud Book or in the Stud Book of their respective breed and must be shown in accordance with their breed standard. Breed Society numbers must be stated on the entry form
16. All Arabs, Part-bred Arabs & Anglo Arabs must be registered in the appropriate register
17. All ridden horses/ponies must be aged 4 years or over on the day of the show
18. All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before January 1st 2010

**** RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE MADE TO ENFORCE THESE RULES ****

Please note that there is no fresh water supply at the showground and competitors are therefore advised to bring their own supply
