

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards

The Fortune Centre Rules

1. All FCRT locations are strictly NO SMOKING
2. No horses or ponies may be ridden on the concrete in front of the looseboxes
3. No dogs
4. No trotting in the yard
5. If horses are in the school the doors must be shut, and re-opened with care as more horses enter
6. There should be no more than eight horses in a school at any one time
7. Please do not allow your horses to drink from the FCRT water buckets (Please note you should bring your own water)
8. **All droppings and any other mess must be cleared up**
9. Please rake the track after use
10. Please do not park in the area beyond the main yard where the muck heap and entry to outdoor school is. There will be parking available in the tree area within the Avon Tyrell activity centre.
11. **Do not throw any rubbish, cups etc inside the stables.**

The West Hants Rules of Entry

Pony Club Showjumping Rules will apply

- 1 Neither the organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses or riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- 2 Hard hats to standard PAS 015, EN 1384 or ASTM 1163 with BS Kite marking and hat tagged. Hats must be worn at all times when riding on the showground.
- 3 The judge's decision is final at all times.
- 4 Excessive use of whips or spurs in events may lead to disqualification.
- 5 NO DOGS ALLOWED AT THIS VENUE, SORRY
- 6 No galloping on the showground.
- 7 Entry fees are non-returnable, except on production of a Veterinary Certificate or Doctor's Certificate.
- 8 No horse/pony to be ridden more than once in any class, except jump-offs
- 9 Objections to be in writing and lodged with the Secretary within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the event with a £5 fee - returnable only if the objection is upheld.
- 11 The Committee reserves the right to -
 - (a) refuse admission to the showground without assigning a reason.
 - (b) reject or cancel or amalgamate classes, according to the number of entries.
 - (c) reject or cancel entries made as they feel fit to do so.
 - (d) request the immediate removal of an animal.
 - (e) retain a minimum of £1.00 per entry in case of the show being cancelled, in order to cover costs
- 12 We would recommend no more than 3 classes per pony
