Ponies must be registered with their respective breed society.
- CLASS 3      VETERANS - 17YRS OLD & OVER  
Age to be clearly displayed
- CLASS 4      COLOURED  
Piebald, Skewbald, Roan, Dun, Palomino, & Spotted.
- CLASS 5      COB/COB TYPE  
Horses/ponies any age or height
- CLASS 6      CROSS/PART BRED  
Open to any horse/pony of a mixed breed
- CLASS 7      BEST CONDITION  
Horses/ponies any age or height

- CLASS 8      CHILD'S PONY - 14.2HH & UNDER

Suitable for several members of the family. Snaffle bridles only
- CLASS 11     REGISTERED MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND  
Ponies must be registered with their respective breed society.
- CLASS 12     NON SHOW TYPE HORSE/PONY  
To be judged on manners and presentation, not conformation
- CLASS 13     COB/COB TYPE  
Horses/ponies any age or height

To be judged on suitability for any riding club activity  
to include a small jump

## Waterside Horse Shows Competition Rules

### Health & Safety

The organisers have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.

### Disclaimer

For the avoidance of doubt and unless explicitly stated to the contrary, medical facilities on the showground will be limited to standard NHS A & E callout.

- Waterside Horse Shows and the landowners accept no responsibility for any damage, accident, injury or loss to competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or any equipment that may be brought on to the show site. It is recommended that competitors have third party public liability insurance.
- Appropriate riding clothes should be worn and hard hats to current standard PAS 015/BS EN 1384 must be worn with the chin strap done up whilst mounted. Body protectors are strongly recommended for jumping.
- All ridden horses must be 4 years and over.
- **The committee are unable to make a refund on entry fees unless a vets or doctors certificate is produced**
- The judge's decision is final at all times.
- Competitors entering classes that coincide do so at their own risk – no refunds will be made.
- Complaints must be made in writing to the secretary within 15 minutes of the end of the class or alleged incident accompanied by a deposit of £10.00. The deposit will be retained if the complaint is considered frivolous or malicious. The committee will give their decision before the end of the show.
- The committee reserves the right to cancel or refuse entry if they deem fit to do so and the right to combine or split any class.
- Any horse/pony or rider considered to be misbehaving may be asked to leave the showground.
- All dogs must be kept on leads and must not be left in cars in hot weather.
- Galloping & excessive use of the practice area is strictly forbidden.
- No horse/pony may be ridden more than once in any class.
